

 - Neighborhood Profiles and Priorities






Plan Framework Map

- The Plan Framework map is essentially a summary of the plan in map form.
 - Shows the interrelatedness of key physical concepts and strategies in the plan.
 - Includes priority focus areas, mixed-use corridors, recommended streetscape improvements, enhanced trail connections, pedestrian crossings, gateway opportunities, and priority mobility routes.
- As we move further into our draft recommendations, we need to begin to identify and prioritize items that should go on the Plan Framework Map.
 - Priority Intersections?
 - Focus Areas?
 - Mobility Corridors?
