

# The Challenge: Expected Growth



# What is a Comprehensive Plan?

An adopted, long-range planning document that provides a strategic direction for the city's policy vision and future growth.

# Why is the Comprehensive Plan Important?


- Helps define the community's vision for the future

- **17 Community Plan** Areas: Areas outside **Regional Centers that** encompass many neighborhoods








